- 6-26-1911. Bldgs. on SE. corner of Main + RR. Burned
- 20th of Aug. Fairfield Investment Co to rebuild, brick & concrete.
- 11-17-1914 The lower park is called Central Park. Deed
accepted from Mr. Service with list of donors as part of deed.
- 6-8-1915 Exp. to operate city for 1916 \$1400⁰⁰
- 9-7-1915 Tichnor St. Bridge over Rattles Run \$385⁰⁰, Miller
Concrete Form Co - Same as one constructed on Main St. 1914
- 3-17-1917 Woman. Council member, Gertrude Waterman
- 5-28-1918 labor 40¢ per hr. + team 35¢ per hr.
- 4-15-1919 In favor of county hi-way on 1st st through Fairfield.
